## MicrOpay Evo Version 9.4 B1

### Introduction

This bulletin release includes two changes to support data sharing between MicrOpay Evo and other Access Evo-enabled products. The items in this bulletin affect Australian payroll databases, only.



#### On-premise (Desktop) Customers

Before updating your MicrOpay Evo software, both the **Payroll** and the **Common** database **must** be backed up. More information about database backup is available in the Knowledge Base article:

### In This Release

- **Updated database views**

Several payroll database views are updated to include additional fields. This change facilitates retrieval of data from these views when queried by Access Evo-connected products.

Transaction ID	Returns the Transaction ID from <i>_eivEmpTrans</i>	_eivPayAdvice
	Returns the Transaction ID from <i>_eivEmpTransCosting</i>	_ipvRBEmpTransCosting _ipvRBEmpTransCostingEOY _ipvRBEmpTransCostingALL
Period Start Date	New field that returns the pay period start date. Calculated value that is based on pay frequency and period end.	_eivPeriods

- **Minor configuration change to Access EarlyPay data hub**

The URL and API credentials used by MicrOpay Evo to exchange data with Access EarlyPay are updated.

## After you upgrade

### For our Payroll Online customers

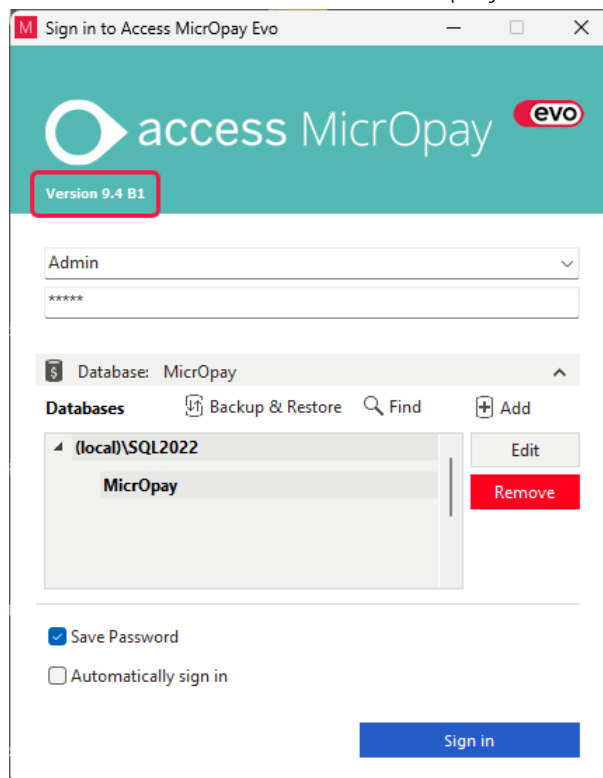
Please note that upgrade of MicrOpay Evo is managed as part of our service to you. You can disregard any comments or instructions that refer to downloading and installing software upgrades.

After the upgrade is installed, you should check that the correct software and database versions are displayed. If the latest version numbers are not displayed, MicrOpay Evo may not have been successfully upgraded.

### To check the MicrOpay Evo software version

In the sign in window:

- After the upgrade is installed the version number displayed should be *9.4 B1*.

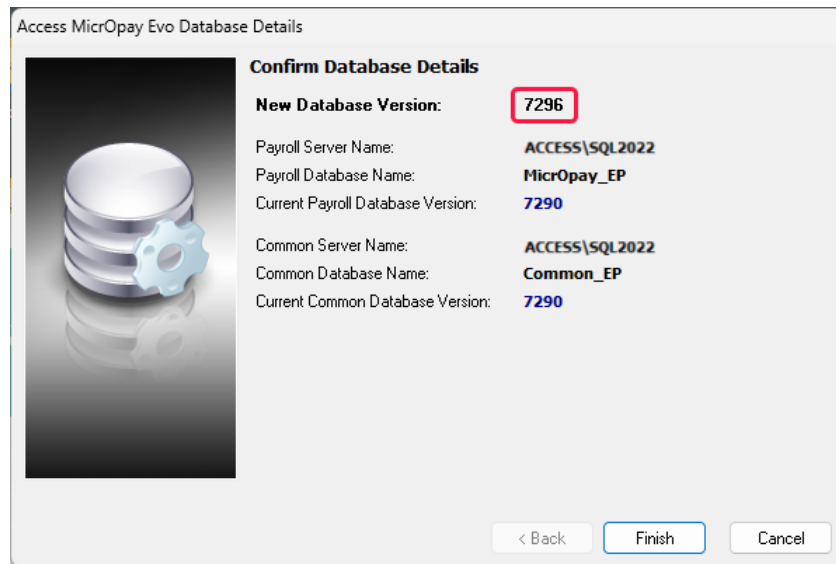


After you have signed in, you can check the version number by going to *Help > About*.

### **To check the MicrOpay Evo database version**

Your new database version number after the upgrade should be **7296**.

The first time you log in to MicrOpay Evo after installing the upgrade, the payroll and common databases will be updated. You can check the new database version from the Confirm Database Details window.



Ensure you click **Finish** to proceed with the database update.
